

Good Energy Feed-in Tariff sign up form

We know Britain can build a renewable energy future, and small-scale generation is vital to achieving this. We are here to help you make it happen.

But while it's great to talk about a positive future, we realise that ensuring it happens involves boring paperwork too. It's vital in fact. We've tried our best to keep this form simple, but there's no disguising the quantity of boxes to be filled in. It should only take about 15 minutes to complete, but we suggest you make yourself a cup of tea, perhaps even grab the biscuit tin, and find a comfy place to seat yourself before diving in.

We can only pay the Feed-in Tariff (FIT) to eligible generators, so please take care to provide all the information we need to ensure you can be correctly accredited. If you would like any assistance when completing the form, or have any questions, then please call our FIT team on 0845 456 1640. We're always happy to help.

If you have more than one generator, please photocopy this form and provide details of any information that is specific to your further generator/s.

Please ensure that all addresses you give on this form are registered with the Post Office. If the address has not been registered this may cause delays with the installation being added to the Ofgem Central FIT Register.

And one more thing, please use BLOCK capitals to ensure we can note your details correctly.

To complete this form you will need

- Your MCS Installer Certificate (it's light blue and should have been given to you by your installer).
- Proof of ID (copy of your passport or drivers licence).
- Proof of ownership (copy of installer's invoice or sale agreement).
- If your installation is Solar PV you will also need the Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) for your property. It is essential that you have an EPC for your property before sending in your application, as it may affect the level of Feed-in Tariff payments you can claim

Please note that we only ask for copies of these documents and do not advise sending in original documents.

FIT payments will be based on the readings from your total generation meter. This is the meter that records how much energy your generator is producing. Please note, this will be a different meter to the one that measures the electricity you import from an electricity supplier. To mark the start of your FIT payments and the date that Good Energy becomes your FIT Licensee we need your initial total generation meter reading. According to Ofgem guidelines, this must be an accurate current meter reading. If the information you provide is incorrect Ofgem may view your actions as fraudulent, delaying the processing of your sign up and affecting your FIT payments.

4. Energy Performance Certificate declarations – Solar PV installations only

All applications for accreditation of new solar PV installations (including extensions to existing installations), with an eligibility date on or after 1 April 2012, need to be accompanied by a copy of this document with the relevant section signed and dated. This will then be used by FITs licencees/Ofgem as appropriate to determine whether or not the energy efficiency requirement applies to your installation and, if so, whether it has been met.
